<u>Process for Curriculum and Clinical Committee Engagement with Learner Representatives – Learner Information</u>

- Two Post-LPN BN representatives will attend meetings and organize events to facilitate communication between faculty and learners
 - Representatives are paid \$50 honourarium per meeting that they attend (including Townhalls)
 - When current representatives are completing their last term, they will be asked to recruit someone to take on their role.
 - Representatives will be provided with a letter affirming their role and service once they have completed.
- Representatives will host townhalls prior to the scheduled clinical and curriculum meetings
 - Representatives will connect with the current Curriculum and Clinical program leads
 - Call will be made by learner representatives to the greater student body for a townhall in the
 - beginning of October
 - beginning of February
 - beginning of May
- Clinical and curriculum committee meetings will be held
 - Beginning of November
 - Beginning of March
 - Beginning of June
 - Representatives will come for the first 20 minutes of the clinical or curriculum (whichever meeting is held FIRST) to share the comments they collected at the townhalls
 - The response to their concerns will be addressed by faculty, compiled, and disseminated within no later than 6 weeks from the meeting.
